



Superintendent's 2011 Income Standards

The Superintendent's Standards are derived from the Low Income Cutoffs (LICO) released by Statistics Canada. The Superintendent uses the before-tax LICO for urban areas with 500,000 people or more. The 2011 standards are updated adding to the 2009 LICO the 2010 Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 1.84% plus a 2.1% adjustment reflecting the 2011 CPI expectation.
