Ltd. from exercising rights and remedies under its lease or at common law arising from non-payment of rent, including:
 - (a) exercising a right of distraint against the Vessel;
 - (b) terminating the lease of the Premises dated effective November 8, 2011; and/or
 - (c) causing the Vessel to be removed from the Premises.
- 6. approval of this Order, other than by counsel for the Applicant, is hereby dispensed with.


