TAKE NOTICE THAT:

- 1.) By Order dated August 24, 2011 of the Federal Court of Canada in the above court proceedings, the court-appointed Monitor, Boale, Wood & Company Ltd., was ordered to notify all creditors who wish to file maritime claims against the Vessel that they must do so by the claims filing deadline of September 9, 2011;
- 2.) In response to that notice, you have filed a proof of claim and have advised the Monitor that you wish to make a maritime claim against the Vessel;
- 3.) That Order of the Federal Court then provides that the Monitor must thereafter notify those persons who have made such maritime claims with the Monitor that those persons must also then file an affidavit in the above proceedings;
- 4.) The affidavit must contain all particulars and documents in support of the maritime claim against the Vessel, specifying the nature of the claim, in order that the Federal Court may determine if such a claim constitutes an *in rem* claim, and the priority position to be given to the claim;
- 5.) **The affidavit must be filed in the above proceedings, at the Federal Court Vancouver Registry at 701 West Georgia Street, 3rd Floor, Vancouver, British Columbia, on or before 4:00 p.m. PST on the 21st day following the day that the *in rem* creditor received this written notice; and**

- 6.) Where an *in rem* creditor does not file an affidavit as specified above with the time specified, the *in rem* claim of such creditor shall be barred unless the Federal Court grants an extension.**

Thereafter, you will be involved in those court proceedings and will be required to assert your claim in the manner to be determined by the Federal Court of Canada.
