ON THE APPLICATION of Comerica Bank coming on for hearing before me this day at Vancouver, British Columbia; AND ON HEARING John I. McLean, Q.C., counsel for Comerica Bank; and those counsel listed on Schedule "A" attached hereto;

THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES that:

- the relief granted to the Petitioners in the Initial Order in these proceedings made on June 6, 2011 is hereby confirmed and extended to February 22, 2013 but only with respect to Worldspan Marine Inc., Crescent Custom Yachts Inc. and Composite FRP Products Ltd. and not with respect to Queenship Marine Industries Ltd. or 27222 Developments Ltd.;
- 2. the stay of proceedings granted by the Initial Order and as extended thereafter is further extended to February 22, 2013 but only as against Worldspan Marine Inc., Crescent Custom Yachts Inc. and Composite FRP Products Ltd. and not as against Queenship Marine Industries Ltd. or 27222 Developments Ltd.;

- 3. subject to further Order of this Court, the Monitor shall use his best efforts to minimize his involvement in these proceedings, subject to him fulfilling his statutory obligations under the *Companies' Creditors Arrangement Act*;
- 4. notwithstanding any term in the Order of Mr. Justice Pearlman dated June 6, 2011 (the "Stay Order"), this Court directs and declares that nothing in the Stay Order in any way prevents, circumscribes or bars 642385 B.C. Ltd. from exercising rights and remedies under its lease or at common law arising from non-payment of rent, including:
 - (a) exercising a right of distraint against the Vessel;
 - (b) terminating the lease of the Premises dated effective November 8, 2011; and/or
 - (c) causing the Vessel to be removed from the Premises.
