



Property Exempt from Seizure – Yukon Territory

Property exempt from seizure is governed under both territorial and federal legislation

- Unencumbered household goods household furniture, utensils and equipment that are contained in and form part of the debtor's permanent home.
- Tools of the trade to a maximum value of \$600.
- Food, fuel and other necessities of life required by the debtor and the family of the debtor for the next 12 months
- House and buildings occupied by the debtor and the lot on which they are situated to a maximum value of \$3,000.00.
- All necessary clothing and all required medical aids (of a debtor or a dependent).
- Certain insurance investments, where designated beneficiary is spouse, child, grandchild, or parent of the person whose life is insured.
- RRSPs, except for contributions made in the previous twelve months.
