

Superintendent's 2017 Income Standards

The Superintendent's Standards are derived from the Low Income Cutoffs (LICO) released by Statistics Canada. The Superintendent uses the before-tax LICO for urban areas with 500,000 people or more. The 2017 standards are updated by adding to the 2015 LICO, the 2016 Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 1.42% plus a 2.0% adjustment reflecting the 2017 CPI expectation.
