



Property Exempt from Seizure – British Columbia

Property exempt from seizure is governed under both provincial and federal legislation

- Unencumbered household goods to a maximum value of \$4,000.
- Tools of the trade to a maximum value of \$10,000.
- Unencumbered motor vehicle to a maximum value of \$5,000 (and \$2,000 for maintenance debtors).
- Equity in a home located in the Capital Regional District and the Metro Vancouver Regional District to a maximum value of \$12,000 (\$9,000 for homes located elsewhere in the province).
- All necessary clothing and all required medical aids (of a debtor or a dependent).
- Certain insurance investments, where designated beneficiary is spouse, child, grandchild, or parent of the person whose life is insured.
- RRSPs, except for contributions made in the previous twelve months.
